Tuition Assistance Information and Process

Catholic schools remain accessible by offering a wide range of tuition assistance options.

Last year, more than \$4.8 million was given to Catholic school students. All tuition assistance applications and procedures are handled on one form that can be obtained through your elementary or secondary school. Even if you have children in more than one Catholic school (elementary and secondary, for example), you can apply for all of your children on one form.

Tuition assistance assessment is handled through the Private School Aid Service (PSAS). This is an independent third-party service that provides reasonable assessments of the ability of families to pay tuition at private and parochial schools.

The PSAS packet can be obtained from your school. The deadline for submitting the PSAS form for the 2009-10 school year is March 13, 2009.

Copies of the PSAS analysis and forms are shared only with the contracting school, parish, or agency; no one else will receive this information. Final decisions about tuition assistance will be communicated to you from your school, the Archdiocese of Louisville, or the Catholic Education Foundation.

Parish membership is not required in order to receive financial assistance.
