Students missing a test are expected to make it up the day they return to school. The Conference Room in the office will be available every day at 7:15 AM. 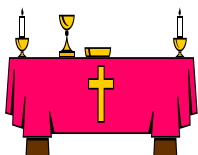

Tardies (as stated in the handbook)

Though students may have entered the building by 7:55, they will be counted tardy if not in their seats and ready to begin by 7:55. Students who come to the cafeteria in the mornings must leave the cafeteria in time to be seated in their homerooms. Parents must accompany their children into the school once the tardy flag is displayed outside by the school office. Parents will be required to sign the tardy book and give the reason for the tardy. Three unexcused late arrivals will be allowed each trimester. A fee of \$5.00 per car pool will be charged for each subsequent late arrival. If continued tardiness persists, the parents and children may have to meet with the principal. Continual lateness is a form of educational neglect.

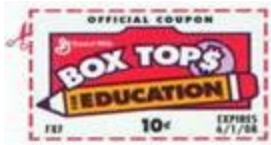
