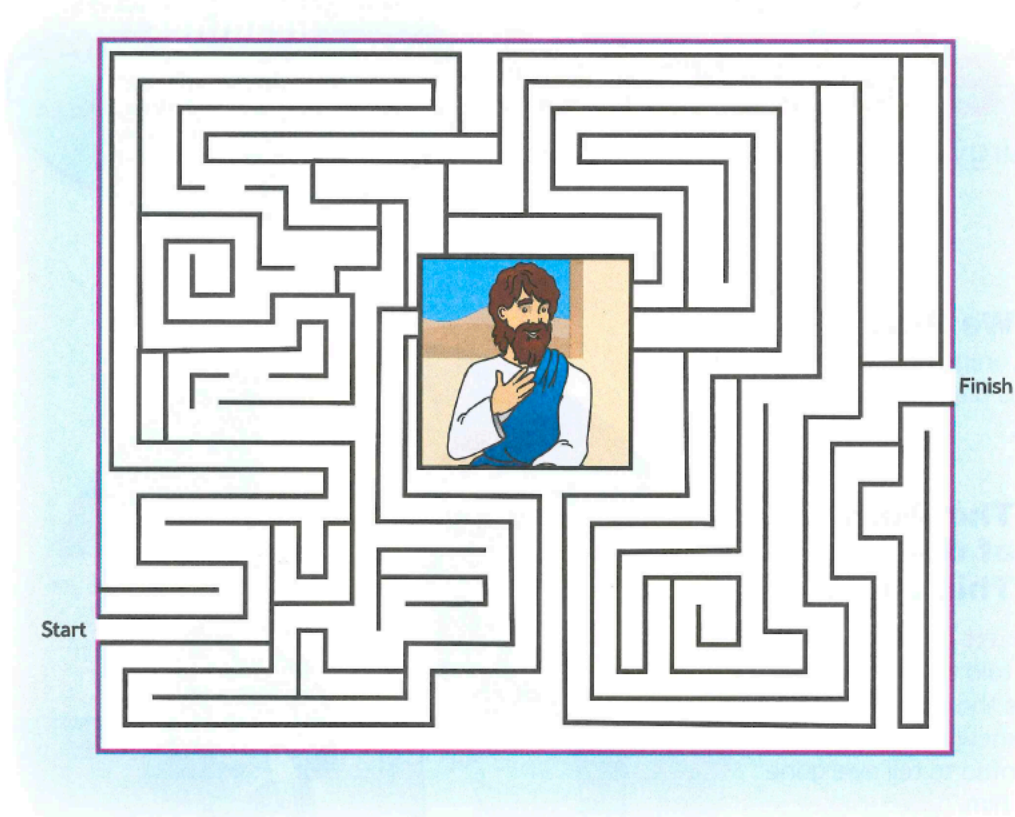


## Activity

Write your worries and concerns on papers and place them in the basket. Spend a few moments in silence, and simply relax in Jesus' presence. (If someone gets the giggles, that's OK.) End simply by saying "Amen." Praying in silence is a good way of letting go of "burdens."
