- 2. 2/19/24 Athletic Board meeting rescheduled for 2/21/24 due to unexpected work event conflict with Teague and unknown return travel time with Kristin
- 3. Opening prayer Fr. Robert

- 5. Athletics eligibility Fr. Robert & Teague Ridge

- a. All Ascension students are eligible to play sports. Non-students may also play contact Eddie, youth formation director, to determine if they meet eligibility
- 6. Safe Environment Training Father Robert
 - a. All coaches or anyone who works with children must complete an initial in-person Safe Environment Training class and have background check completed. Online Safe Environment renewal classes and background check is required every five years. Sport coordinator should provide Donna a list of all coaches and those who work with children prior to sport beginning. Donna will communicate with individuals who need training/background check and will manage that database. Father will find out if youth volunteers (high school, etc.) need this
- 7. Revisit Concessions Manager Fr. Robert & Teague Ridge
 - a. Kristin will have this position posted; will close March 31st
- 8. 3-8 Boys & Girls Basketball Recap Dink Horstman
 - a. Teague discussed it was a great season for 7th and 8th grade boys. #2 won city championship, #1 runner-up. The support from the school community was amazing.
 - b. Teague shared we have received amazing feedback from schools, coaches and parents across the CSAA again this year about our Christmas tournament
 - c. Dink shared 3rd and 4th grade had good seasons. Parents elected for 12 on 1 team instead of two teams of 6 (girls).
- 9. JK-2 Coed Basketball Recap Chris Neichter season went well. Preferred games here to Gabriel. Brian had to fill in for ref. Want to host again.
- 10. Coaches Evaluations Teague Ridge evaluations sent out for basketball, responses coming in.
 - a. Evaluations will be sent to coordinators to disseminate
 - b. Matt Sanderfer addressed the board about basketball concern over lack of interest in playing at middle school level for girls. He suggests 5th & 6th grade girls have a lack of playing time during games and practice for some girls which may cause lack of interest/enrollment. Several board members have witnessed and validated this concern. Once Dink has time to digest the feedback around this coach, the board will discuss again.
- 11. Swim Update Stephanie Koenig: Kristin shared info that Stephanie provided prior to the meeting: practices going well, meet in March
- 12. Boys Volleyball Update Stephen Hoard
 - a. 8th grade boys coach needs to get training updated (expired)- make sure Donna has initiated a background check. Trained individual will fill in in the meantime
 - b. Season has started. 2 teams at 1st and 2nd grade. 3rd and 4th grade 1 team (starts Saturday). Hosting games on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Dink and Chris helped Stephen with concessions and hosting our first game last night.
 - c. Hoard asked if workers need to be in high school. Board agreed workers should be in high school, if possible.
